
# Aqua Descaler Instruction Guide



## **RECOMMENDED EQUIPMENT**

#### **IMPORTANT**

Prior to use, apply suitable gloves, clothing, eye and face protection. If applying in an indoor environment make sure the room is well-ventilated. For best results we recommend applying Aqua Descaler using a pressurised garden sprayer to apply an even coat and reduce wastage.

# For pool widths over 4m we recommend attaching a 2m lance extension.

#### DOSAGE

Allow 1 litre per 10 SQM cover area to help remove light scale deposits or use as a preventative measure. For heavy scale contanimation, three to four applications may be necessary.


#### STEP 1

Pour 5 litre Aqua Descaler in to a pressurised garden sprayer (protect floor area as chemical is a powerful acidic cleaner that may stain, affect floor finish.


Apply, Descaler to 1-2 SQM surface area at time. Leave for 30-45 minutes. Do not apply in wet weather or if there is surface water present on cover.

**REMOVE CALCIUM** 

#### STEP 2

After 30 minutes, the Descaler will have started to breakdown calcium deposits.

Using an 18" pool brush or soft plastic scraper remove the undissolved deposits into pool water. Rinse off the cover using a hose pipe or flood the slats in one metre increments by gently depressing the slat ends encouraging water onto the surface. Remove the cover to remove surface water. Any calcium entering the pool can be vacuumed at a later stage.

Repeat above steps until all Calcium deposits have been removed.

Once the cover has been treated, check pH levels and adjust as necessary. As a preventative measure, we recommend using Aqua Descaler at regular intervals, every 8-12 weeks.

Aqua Descaler is a very powerful acidic cleaner for removing scale deposits from PVC and slatted covers. Contains HEDP and Phosphoric acid.

Apply undiluted directly to PVC or Polycarbonate slats using a watering can or ideally a 5/10 Ltr garden sprayer (pressurised) vessel. For wide cover widths, we recommend using a lance extension. Spray sprayer (pressureed) vesses. For white cover widths, we recommend using a latter extension. Spray stats evenly. Leave for 30 minutes. Use an 18" pool brush to help remove stubborn calcium deposits. Rinse cover with clean water. Two to three application applications may be necessary to remove heavy calcium contamination. Coverage approximately 1 L per 10 m2 surface area. Rinse all containers thoroughly after use. Check pool pH after each treatment and adjust as necessary.
